

## Gold Coast Highway asphalting works Broadbeach

From 4:00am Tuesday 22 October 2013 to 10:00am Thursday 24 October 2013, asphalting works will occur on the Gold Coast Highway in the centre median, opposite the Gold Coast Convention and Exhibition Centre. For the duration, continuous day and night works will occur.

### Traffic changes:

- Access to the Gold Coast Convention and Exhibition Centre will be left-in/left-out only.
- Southbound right turn access into the Gold Coast Convention and Exhibition Centre will be closed. Access is available via T E Peters Drive.
- Right turn exit out of the Gold Coast Convention and Exhibition Centre will be closed. Southbound access is available via the Gold Coast Highway, Australia Avenue and Surf Parade.
- Gold Coast Convention and Exhibition Centre bus stop and services will not be impacted.
- Taxi services to the Gold Coast Convention and Exhibition Centre will be maintained.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area. Temporary footpath closures near the active work area will occur and alternative routes will be signed.



### What to expect:

- Installation of safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and crane movements to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Construction of new footpaths, kerbs and roadway.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.

### Night works:

- Night works will be required as part of these works to minimise the impact on businesses, pedestrians and traffic. Affected businesses and residents will be notified in advance of night works.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
