

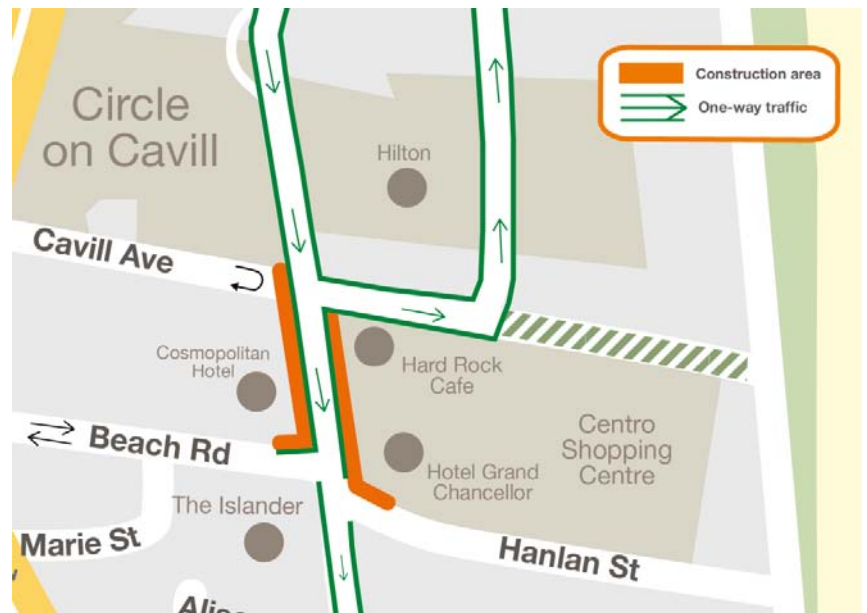
## Cavill Avenue Intersection Finishing Works

From 6:30am Monday 11 November to 6:30pm Wednesday 13 November 2013, Cavill Avenue will be closed to traffic at Surfers Paradise Boulevard to facilitate finishing works.

Finishing works include the construction of asphalt, kerbing and guttering. These works are expected to take three days to complete.

### Traffic changes:

- Cavill Avenue will be closed to east-bound traffic at the intersection with Surfers Paradise Boulevard (see map).
- A u-turn facility will be managed on Cavill Avenue under traffic control for local access, deliveries and waste management via the Gold Coast Highway.
- Southbound traffic along Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be maintained.
- Access to Cavill Avenue (east) Mall and Orchid Avenue will be maintained via Surfers Paradise Boulevard.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area. Temporary footpath closures near the active work area will occur and alternative routes will be signed.
- During construction, please drive to the conditions at all times as points of access, temporary lane closures and changes to traffic flow will occur.



### What to expect:

- Installation of safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area.
- Heavy machinery, such as vibration rollers to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- The majority of construction work will be carried out between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.

### Night works:

- Night works will be required as part of these works to minimize the impact on businesses, pedestrians and traffic. Affected businesses and residents will be notified in advance of night works.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
