



## Night works on Surfers Paradise Boulevard

**From Friday 15 November 2013, works to install underground services will begin at Surfers Paradise Boulevard, adjacent to Hard Rock, and continue for up to one week. Temporary footpath and lane closures may occur, however local access to businesses will be maintained at all times.**

### What to expect:

- Installation of temporary safety fencing and hoarding to contain the work area at night.
- Construction will involve installing services and constructing pits below ground.
- Construction will involve the use of heavy machinery, including vacuum excavators, to install underground services.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration will occur. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Pedestrian access and access to businesses will be maintained around the work site at all times.
- Traffic management will be in place motorists. Please drive to the conditions at all times as points of access will change.
- Pedestrian access and access to businesses will be maintained around the work site at all times.
- The majority of construction work will occur from Monday to Friday, 9:30pm to 6:30am.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
