



Parking and traffic changes in Surfers Paradise

Following successful completion of kerb-to-kerb works on Surfers Paradise Boulevard between Elkhorn Avenue and Cavill Avenue, GoldLinQ delivered on its promise to remove construction fencing where possible.

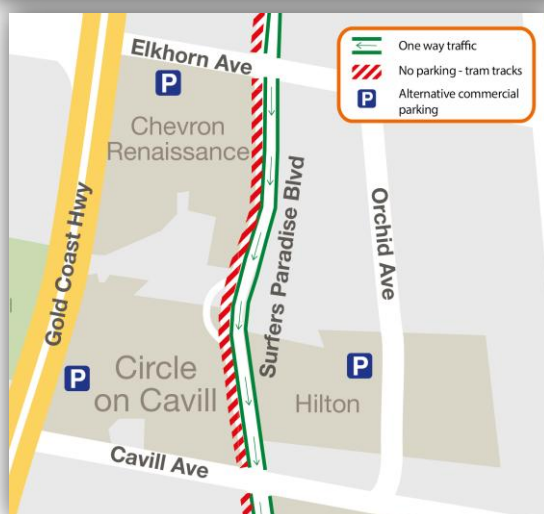
As part of the kerb-to-kerb works, on-street parking along sections of Surfers Paradise Boulevard have been permanently removed in line with the final traffic configuration.

Changing driver behaviour prior to tram operations commencing is vital for safety.

Parking across tram tracks is illegal and unsafe, even when trams are not operating.

Penalties apply for illegal parking and should parking on tracks continue, GoldLinQ will be required to re-erect fencing in the interest of public safety. Vehicles parking across tracks risk City of Gold Coast parking fines and may be towed to ensure tracks remain clear.

GoldLinQ encourages local traders to inform their clientele and staff they are required not to park on tram tracks and to promote parking in the nearby commercial parking facilities shown on the maps below. Delivery drivers should only use loading zones.

Follow the road rules

- Obey Queensland road rules, signs and signals when driving around the light rail system.
- Tracks are for trams - never queue across the tracks.
- Remember to U-Turn only where a U-Turn Permitted sign is displayed.

New traffic signs

Keep an eye out for new traffic signs being introduced across the city including:

- KEEP TRACKS CLEAR:** don't stop on the tracks as a tram may approach.
- WATCH FOR TRAMS:** when walking, cycling or driving always look out for trams.
- T TRAFFIC LIGHTS:** are for trams only you don't have to stop on a red 'T'.

Use designated crossings

Always cross the road and tram tracks at designated crossings points. Remember to look both ways before crossing.

Stay alert

Trams are quiet don't be distracted by music or your phone. Pay attention to your surroundings and keep a safe distance from moving trams.



There are a number of public and private parking areas in Surfers Paradise.

City of Gold Coast parking stations

- Bruce Bishop Car Park: Entry via Beach Road and Gold Coast Highway. Holds 1600 cars for short term or all day parking. First 2 hours parking free, third hour \$4.40 and \$2.20 for each additional hour.
- The corner of Via Roma and Gold Coast Highway: 3 hours free parking Monday to Friday.
- View Venue Car Park: 4 hours parking at a rate of \$1.40 per hour.

Commercial car parking station

- PriPark Car Park: Corner of Ferny Avenue (Gold Coast Highway) and Pine Avenue. Entry via Pine or Norfolk Avenue. Operates at a rate of \$1.00 per hour with a maximum of \$5.00 per day.

Shopping centres and hotel parking

- Chevron Renaissance Car Park: Entry via Elkhorn Avenue and Ferny Avenue (Gold Coast Highway). Holds 300 cars for short term or all day parking. Open 24 hours. Parking is free for the first 2 hours with a minimum spend of \$10 or more in-centre.
- Circle on Cavill Car Park: Entry via Cavill Avenue and Ferny Avenue (Gold Coast Highway). Holds 429 cars for short term or all day parking. Open 24 hours. Parking is free for the first 2 hours with a minimum spend of \$10 or more in-centre.
- Secure Parking Centro Shopping Centre Car Park: entry via Hanlon Street. Holds 450 cars for short term or all day parking. Open 24 hours. Early bird all day parking only \$8 (quotas and conditions apply).



- Secure Parking Soul Car Park: Entry via The Esplanade. Holds 200 cars for short term or all day parking. Refer to www.secureparking.com.au for operating hours. For discounted monthly parking rates please call 1300 727 483.
- Secure Parking Hilton Hotel Car Park: Entry via Orchid Avenue. Holds 113 cars for short term or all day parking. Refer to www.secureparking.com.au for operating hours. For discounted monthly parking rates please call 1300 727 483.
- Outrigger Hotel and Piazza Shopping Centre: Entry via View Avenue. Holds 300 cars for short term or all day parking. Operates at a rate of \$8.00 per day.

Loading bays and disabled parking

Some loading zones will be unavailable during construction and some removed permanently. Alternative access will be provided where possible. Disabled parking will be maintained in the vicinity but will move in accordance with construction work areas.

Stay safe

- Remember tracks are for trams. When driving only cross the tracks at designated intersections and never queue or park on the tracks.
- Never drive, park, walk or cycle along the tracks and always cross at designated pedestrian crossings.
- Always follow the current Queensland road rules around the light rail system.
