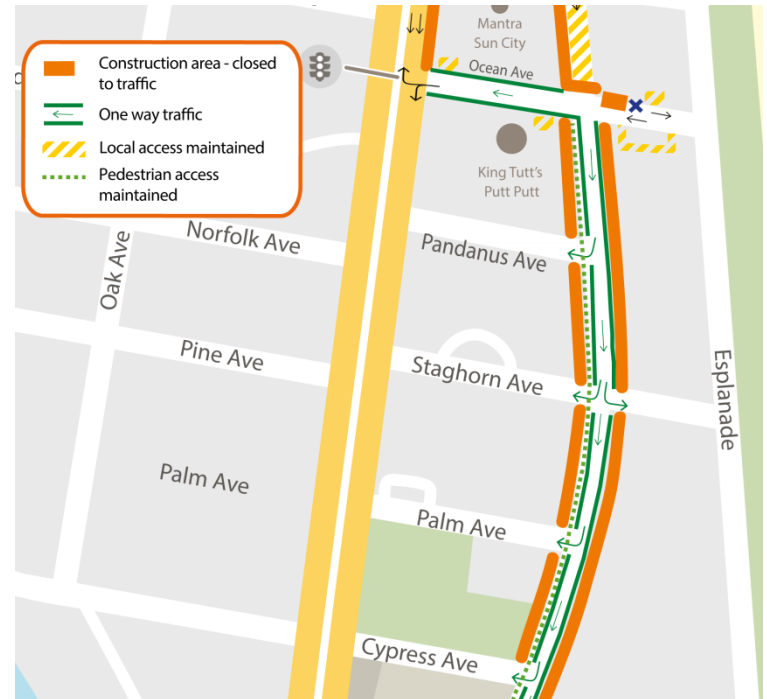


Footpath and Landscaping Construction Ocean Avenue to Cypress Avenue

From Monday 25 November 2013, footpath and landscaping works will begin along Surfers Paradise Boulevard from Ocean Avenue to Cypress Avenue.

Traffic changes:

- Southbound traffic on Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be maintained, however points of access, temporary traffic holds and changes to traffic flow will occur.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained along the light rail tracks (see map).
- Footpath closures along the eastern and western footpaths will occur to facilitate construction.
- Pedestrian and vehicles access for residents and businesses will be maintained during these works.
- Alternative routes and redirections will be signed. Please drive to the conditions at all times.



What to expect:

- Installation of safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area.
- Heavy machinery, such as jack-hammering, excavation and crane movements, will be used to facilitate construction.
- Vegetation clearing and removal to facilitate the installation of new landscaping.
- Construction noise, vibration and dust. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- The majority of construction work will be carried out between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.
- Night works may be required as part of these works to minimise the impact on businesses, pedestrians and traffic. Affected businesses and residents will be notified in advance of night works.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
