



Night works at Hooker Boulevard intersection

Night works to install traffic signals and underground service works will occur at the intersection of Hooker Boulevard, Margaret Avenue and Gold Coast Highway intersection from Tuesday 28 January for up to two weeks.

These works will be undertaken at night to minimise the impact on traffic and surrounding residents and businesses.

What to expect:

- Construction will involve the use of heavy machinery, including excavators.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration will occur. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Single lane closures on the Gold Coast Highway will occur.
- Vehicle access will be maintained at the intersection under traffic control.
- Pedestrian access around the work area will be maintained.
- Construction work will be carried out from 6:30pm to 6:30am, Sunday to Thursday.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
