



## Traffic changes at Ferny Avenue (Gold Coast Highway)

From Tuesday 28 January to Saturday 8 February 2014, a number of traffic changes will take place on the Gold Coast Highway southbound at the intersection with Surfers Paradise Boulevard and Ferny Avenue.

### Traffic changes

*From Monday 28 January 2014*

- The Gold Coast Highway will be closed to all southbound traffic from the intersection at Ferny Avenue to Ocean Avenue.
- Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be reopened to southbound traffic from the intersection at Ferny Avenue to Ocean Avenue.
- Southbound traffic on the Gold Coast Highway will be diverted to Surfers Paradise Boulevard or Ferny Avenue.
- Southbound traffic on Surfer Paradise Boulevard will be given priority right turn movements into Ocean Avenue, which remains one way, to return to the Gold Coast Highway (see map).
- Local access to Golden Gate will be maintained via the Gold Coast Highway.
- Temporary traffic signals at the intersection of Ferny Avenue and Main Beach Parade will remain in place.



Traffic changes effective from Monday 28 January 2014.

*From Saturday 1 February 2014*

- One lane southbound will be reopened on the Gold Coast Highway southbound from the intersection at Ferny Avenue to Ocean Avenue (see map).
- One lane of southbound traffic on the Gold Coast Highway will be diverted to Surfers Paradise Boulevard.
- Access into Ferny Avenue will remain in place.
- Temporary traffic signals at the intersection of Ferny Avenue and Main Beach Parade will remain in place.

## From Saturday 8 February 2014

- The Gold Coast Highway will be reopened to all southbound traffic from the intersection at Ferny Avenue to Ocean Avenue.
- Southbound traffic lanes on Surfers Paradise Boulevard and Ferny Avenue will remain in place.
- Temporary traffic signals at the intersection of Ferny Avenue and Main Beach Parade will be decommissioned.



Traffic changes effective from Saturday 8 February 2014.

## What to expect:

- Alternative routes and redirections will be signed. Please drive to the conditions at all times during construction as points of access, temporary lane closures and changes to traffic flow will occur.
- Installation of safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavation and vibration rolling, to facilitate construction.
- Works will involve underground service installations, construction of new footpaths, kerbing, and roadway.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area. Temporary footpath closures near the active work area will occur and alternative routes will be signed.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- The majority of construction work will be carried out between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.

## Night works:

- Night works will be required as part of these works.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
