

Parklands Drive asphaltting

From Wednesday 12 to Friday 14 February 2014, nightworks to install asphalt on Parklands Drive between Smith Street and Engineering Drive will occur between 7pm and 5am, weather permitting.

Two-way traffic access on Parklands Drive will be maintained under traffic control between Smith Street and Engineering Drive.

Engineering Drive and Alumni Place will be closed to traffic access during these works, with alternative access available via University Drive.

Bus changes

The bus stops on Parklands Drive near Engineering Drive will be temporarily closed during these works.

The nearest alternative bus stops are located 600 metres north west on Parklands Drive adjacent to University Drive and Gold Coast University Hospital.



What to expect

- Stop-go traffic control in place on Parklands Drive between Smith Street and Engineering Drive from 7pm to 5am.
- Engineering Drive will be partially closed under police control.
- Access to Parklands Drive via Olsen Avenue will remain unchanged.
- Large machinery to install final asphalt.
- Some noise, dust, vibration and asphalt related fumes at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
- During construction, please drive to the conditions and obey all instructions given by traffic controllers.

Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.
