

## Northbound lane closures on Scarborough Street

From Monday 17 February 2014, the northbound lane of Scarborough Street, Southport will be temporarily closed between Nerang Street and Queen Street while footpath paving, landscape and finishing works occur.

Northbound closures will be undertaken progressively in two phases (see map):

- Phase 1- Northbound closure between Lawson Street and Young Street for approximately two to three weeks.
- Phase 2- Northbound traffic is reinstated in the Phase 1 zone and closure will occur between Queen Street and Lawson Street for approximately six weeks.

Night closures of the southbound lane from Nerang Street to Queen Street will continue from 7pm to 5am Monday to Friday.

Pedestrian access and local access to driveways and businesses between Nerang Street and Queen Street will be maintained.

### Traffic changes:

- Scarborough Street northbound will be closed in two phases.
- Scarborough Street southbound will be maintained during weekdays and weekends. Night closures of the southbound lane will continue Monday to Friday from 7pm to 5am.
- Northbound detours will be via Queen, Garden and Young Streets.
- Through traffic will be maintained on Lawson and Short Streets.

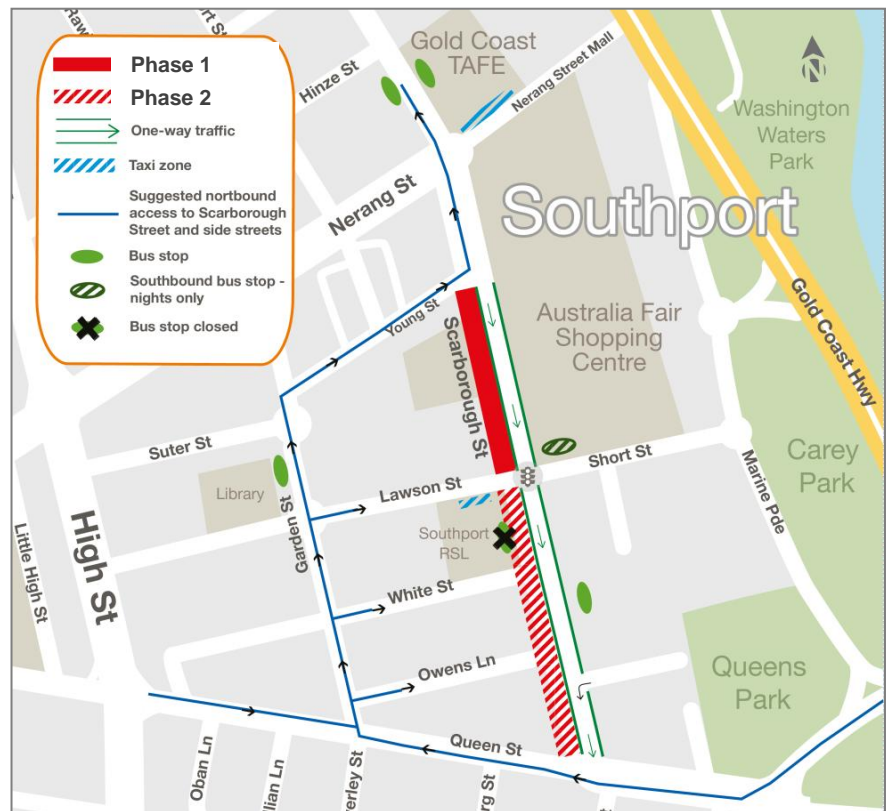
### What to expect:

- Construction crews will work day and night Monday to Saturday to complete the finishing works.
- Night works will be required from 6:30pm to 6:30am.
- Pedestrian access will be signed around the work area, detours will be in place.
- Safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area will be in place.
- Construction will include excavation, concreting and installation of paving and landscaping.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residents.

## Bus changes on Scarborough Street

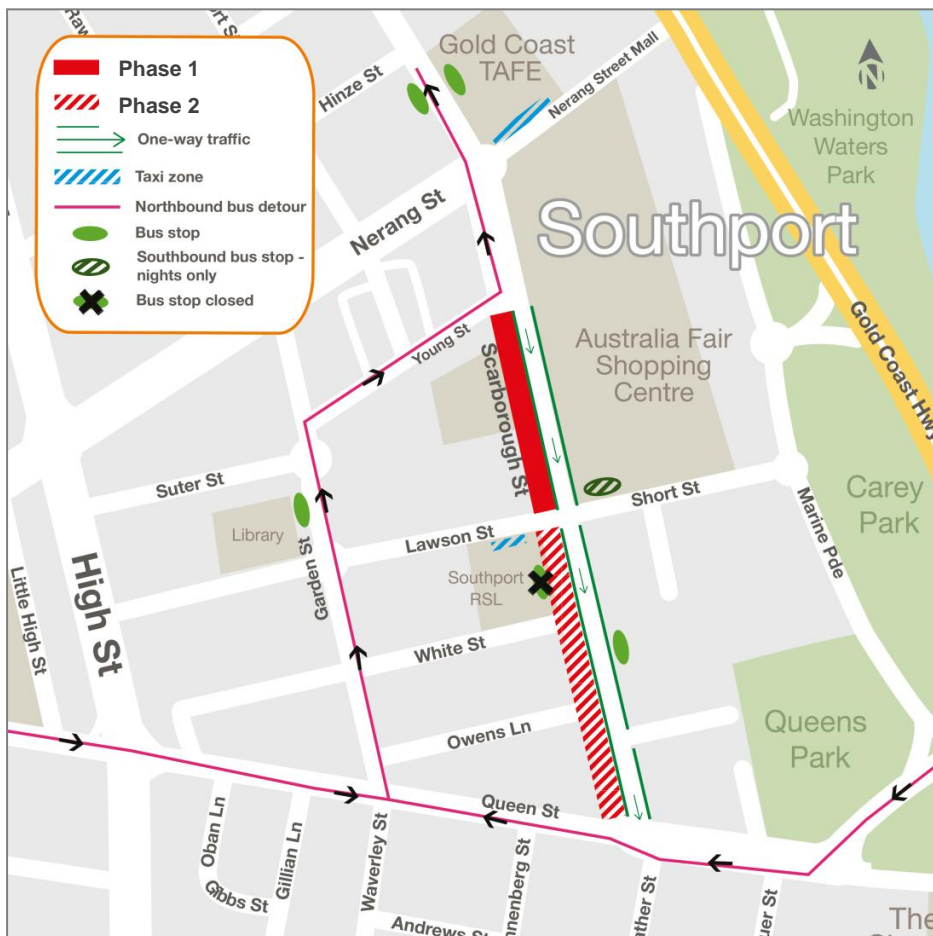
From 5:00am Monday 17 February 2014, several changes to bus routes and bus stop locations in Scarborough Street, Southport will occur during northbound lane closures.

### Bus route and stop changes:

- The southbound bus stop on Scarborough Street will be maintained during the day and on weekends.
- During night closures of the southbound lane from 7pm to 5am Monday to Friday, the bus stop near Westpac will be closed. A temporary southbound bus stop will be located at Short Street during these times.
- Northbound bus routes 700, 703, 704, 731, 737, 741, 742, 747 will be diverted via Queen Street, Garden Street and Young Street.
- The northbound bus stop on the western side of Scarborough Street near Southport RSL will be temporarily closed. A temporary bus stop will be located near the Southport Library on Garden Street (see map).
