



## Temporary road closure and diversion

**To facilitate underground services construction, a temporary road closure will occur along Surfers Paradise Boulevard between Elkhorn Avenue and Cavill Avenue on Monday 10 February 2014, from 6:30pm to 6:30am.**

**These works are scheduled to take place at night to minimise the impact on traffic and surrounding residents and businesses.**

### Night works:

- Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be closed to all through traffic between the intersection of Elkhorn Avenue and Cavill Avenue.
- Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be reopened to all southbound traffic the following morning.
- This work will be carried out between 6:30pm and 6:30am, Monday 10 February 2014.
- Construction will involve relocating services, above and below ground, such as gas, water and electricity, and upgrading storm water drainage.
- Alternative routes and redirections will be signed. Please drive to the conditions at all times during construction.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration may occur. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
