

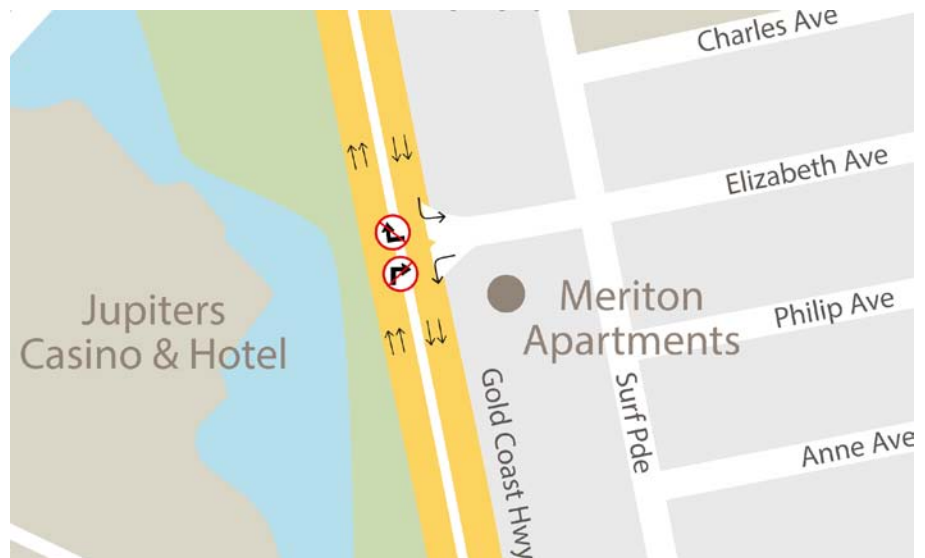


Elizabeth Avenue Intersection Traffic Signal Works

From 7:00pm Sunday 16 February to 6:30am Wednesday 19 February 2014, continuous works will occur at Elizabeth Avenue and the Gold Coast Highway intersection to facilitate traffic signal works.

Traffic changes:

- Elizabeth Avenue will be closed to right in and right out traffic movements (see map).
- Left in and left out traffic movements will be maintained.
- Southbound and northbound traffic will be maintained along the Gold Coast Highway.
- The intersection will be managed under traffic control for the duration of works.
- Pedestrian access routes will be maintained around the construction area. Temporary footpath closures near the active work area will occur and alternative routes will be signed.
- Alternative routes and redirections will be signed. Please drive to the conditions at all times during construction as points of access, temporary lane closures and changes to traffic flow will occur.



What to expect:

- Installation of safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area and to assist traffic movement.
- Construction will include the installation of traffic signals underground.
- Heavy machinery, such as excavators to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather and construction conditions.

Night works:

- Night works will be required as part of these works.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
