



## Night works along the Gold Coast Highway, Broadbeach

**Night works to facilitate centre median and island works will occur at the intersections of Convention Centre, T E Peters Drive and Victoria Avenue from Monday 10 March for up to three weeks.**

**Asphalting works will also occur at Broadbeach South Station.**

**These works will be undertaken at night to minimise the impact on traffic and surrounding residents and businesses.**

### What to expect:

- Construction will involve the use of heavy machinery, including excavators.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration will occur. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Lane closures will occur around the work site.
- Vehicle access will be maintained at the intersections under traffic control.
- Pedestrian access around the work area will be maintained.
- Construction work will be carried out from 6:30pm to 6:30am, Monday to Saturday.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
