



Night works along the Gold Coast Highway, Broadbeach

Night works to facilitate centre median and island works will occur at the intersections of Convention Centre, T E Peters Drive and Victoria Avenue from Monday 10 March for up to three weeks.

Asphalting works will also occur at Broadbeach South Station.

These works will be undertaken at night to minimise the impact on traffic and surrounding residents and businesses.

What to expect:

- Construction will involve the use of heavy machinery, including excavators.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration will occur. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Lane closures will occur around the work site.
- Vehicle access will be maintained at the intersections under traffic control.
- Pedestrian access around the work area will be maintained.
- Construction work will be carried out from 6:30pm to 6:30am, Monday to Saturday.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
