



Night Works on Surfers Paradise Boulevard

From Monday 17 March 2014, night works for underground service installation will take place along the eastern footpath of Surfers Paradise Boulevard, from Main Beach Parade to Ocean Avenue. These works are scheduled to take place at night to minimise the impact on traffic and are anticipated to take up to three nights to complete, weather permitting.

Night works:

- Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be closed to southbound traffic each night from 7:00pm to 6:30am. Local access will be maintained.
- Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be reopened to southbound traffic each morning.
- Installation of temporary safety fencing and hoarding to contain the work area at night.
- Construction will include the use of heavy machinery, including vacuum excavators, to investigate underground services.
- Traffic management will be in place to assist pedestrians and motorists. Please drive to the conditions at all times during construction.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration may occur. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
