Remember to obey all signs and signals at all times.

Overhead wires are live and trams are testing from the Gold Coast University Hospital Station at Parklands Drive to Broadbeach South Station.

Always cross at designated crossings and look both ways before crossing the road and light rail tracks.

Work this weekend

From 7:00pm Friday 21 to 5:00am Monday 24 March the southbound lane of Scarborough Street will be closed at the Nerang Street intersection for road construction ahead of final asphaltting.

Traffic control and detours will be in place for southbound traffic via Hinze, Davenport, Garden and Lawson Streets.

Parklands

Kerb, footpath, drainage and landscaping works including night works continue.

Southport

Queen Street

From Wardoo Street to Nerang Street

Finishing works continue including night works.

Nerang Street

Between Queen and Davenport Street

Landscaping works including construction of planter boxes in the parking lane will occur. Finishing works will continue including night works.

Between Davenport Street and Scarborough Street

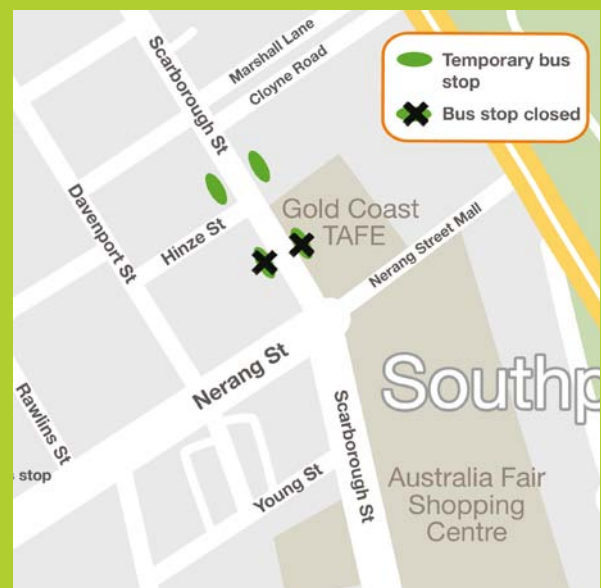
Paving, landscaping and station works continue including night works.

Scarborough Street

Scarborough Street bus stop relocation

The following temporary bus stop relocations will occur to facilitate construction works in the area:

- From 7:00pm Friday 21 March the southbound bus stop in front of the Gold Coast Institute of TAFE building will be temporarily relocated 100 metres north near Cloyne Road.
- From 5:00am Monday 24 March the northbound bus stop in front of Southport Police station will be temporarily relocated 100 metres north between Hinze and Hicks Street.



Scarborough Street closures

The northbound lane of Scarborough Street is temporarily closed between White and Queen Street while footpath, landscape and finishing works occur.

Night closures of the southbound lane from Nerang Street to Queen Street will continue from 7:00pm to 5:00am, Monday to Friday.

Southport paving and night works

Footpath and landscape works are underway in Southport. The work involves jack-hammering and removing the current pavement, replacing and levelling underground service pit lids and laying a new concrete base and pavers.

Day, night and weekend work will occur.

Near Hinze Street

Day and night works will occur to complete new footpaths and commence construction of new bus stops. Business access will be maintained.

Finishing works will continue including landscaping, concreting medians, underground services and footpath works.

Between Nerang Street and Queen Street

Paving, concrete pours, demolition and retaining wall construction will continue from Lawson Street to Nerang Street on the eastern and western footpaths.

Pit levelling will continue on the western footpath between Queen Street and White Street.

Landscaping works continue.

Queen Street

From Scarborough Street to Barney Street

Night works will continue for landscaping and finishing works. Lane closures will continue. Asphaltting works will also occur.

Como Crescent and Brighton Parade

The northern access to Como Crescent near the Shores building will remain closed for asphaltting works. Access is maintained via the southern entry near Rivage Royale (see map). Traffic will be maintained in both directions on Brighton Parade with temporary lights and traffic control.



Nerang River

Shared cycle and pedestrian bridge

Piling works continue on the northern side with changes to the pedestrian access on the boardwalk. Girder delivery and installation will continue at night with lane closures on the existing traffic bridge.

Nerang River barge movements

The barge Leonora is on the northern side of the river to the east of the traffic bridge. Mariners are advised to use caution. Details are available on the [Maritime Safety Queensland website](#).

Paradise Waters

Gold Coast Highway

Intermittent night works along the Gold Coast Highway from the Sundale Bridge to Ferny Avenue intersection will occur.

Single lane closures and detours will be in place along the Gold Coast Highway including traffic and police control at intersections.

Landscape works continue along Commodore Drive and at the Admiralty Drive intersection. Lane closures will occur. Finishing and station works continue.

Ferny Avenue to View Avenue

Finishing works, including asphaltting, kerbing, footpaths and landscaping continue. Night and weekend works will occur. Station works continue.

Night works continue at various locations from Ocean Avenue to View Avenue to inspect and rectify drainage manholes.

From Monday 24 March the southbound bus stop on the Gold Coast Highway at Ocean Avenue will be temporarily relocated 100metres north, adjacent to Golden Gate. Services will not be affected.

Surfers Paradise Boulevard closed from Staghorn Avenue to Cypress Avenue

From Monday 24 March Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be closed to traffic from Staghorn Avenue to Palm Avenue for up to one week to facilitate footpath construction works.

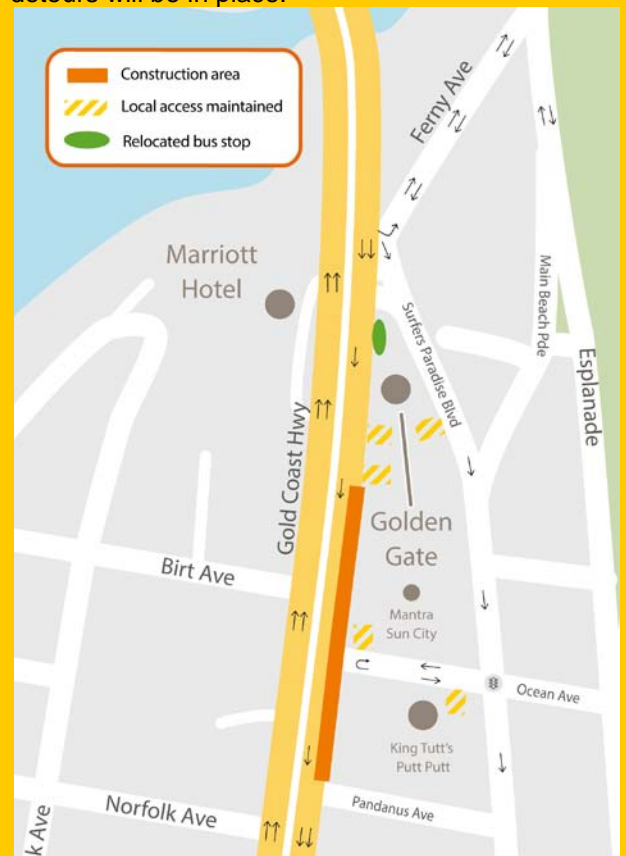
From Wednesday 26 March Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be closed to traffic from Palm Avenue to Cypress Avenue for up to one week to facilitate footpath construction works.

Traffic Changes on the Gold Coast Highway and Ocean Avenue

From Monday 24 March construction will begin to install a right turn lane from the Gold Coast Highway northbound into Ocean Avenue. The Gold Coast Highway will be reduced to one lane southbound from Ferny Avenue intersection to Pandanus Avenue. Ocean Avenue will be reopened to two-way traffic but closed at the Gold Coast Highway intersection (see map).

Day, night and weekend work will occur. Traffic detours will be in place.



View Avenue to Elkhorn Avenue

Works continue to upgrade underground services. Night works to complete footpath subgrade installation will commence along the western footpath from Sunday 23 March.

Elkhorn Avenue to Trickett Street

Paving and night works on Surfers Paradise Boulevard from Elkhorn Avenue to Trickett Street

Footpath and landscaping works continue along Surfers Paradise Boulevard between Elkhorn Avenue and Trickett Street. The work involves jack-hammering and removing the current pavement and driveways, replacing and levelling underground service pit lids and laying a concrete base.

Footpath removal and reinstatement works are underway along:

- The western footpath from Elkhorn Avenue to Alison Street
- The eastern footpath from Cavill Avenue to Trickett Street.

Paver removal continues along the eastern footpath from Elkhorn to Cavill Avenue.

Day, night and weekend work will occur.

Station works continue.

Trickett Street to Hamilton Avenue

Footpath night works on Surfers Paradise Boulevard from Trickett Street to Hamilton Avenue

Footpath and landscaping works continue along Surfers Paradise Boulevard between Trickett Street and Hamilton Avenue. The work involves jack-hammering and removing the current pavement and driveways, replacing and levelling underground service pit lids and laying a concrete base.

Footpath removal and reinstatement works are underway along:

- The eastern footpath from Laycock Street to Clifford Street

Preparatory footpath removal and watermain investigation works continue along the western footpath from Alison Street to Clifford Street.

Day, night and weekend work will occur.

From Monday 24 March Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be closed to traffic from Laycock Street to Clifford Street for up to two weeks to facilitate footpath construction works. Night works will occur.

Clifford Street to Thornton Street

Works continue for underground services, traffic signals, street lighting, footpaths, landscaping and station works. Night works may occur.

Broadbeach

Overhead wires are live and trams are testing from Southport to Broadbeach

Overhead wires are live and trams are testing from the Gold Coast University Hospital Station at Parklands Drive to Broadbeach South Station.

Always cross at designated crossings and look both ways before crossing the road and light rail tracks.

Gold Coast Highway

Fern Street to Australia Avenue

Landscaping and station works continue. Lane closures will occur.

Australia Avenue to Hooker Boulevard

Centre median and island works at the intersections of Convention Centre, T E Peters Drive and Victoria Avenue. Night works and lane closures will occur.

Footpath, landscaping, energex and station works continue. Lane closures will occur.

Pacific Fair Drive

Road works continue on Pacific Fair Drive. Lane closures will occur and access will be maintained under traffic control.

Timing of these works is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.
