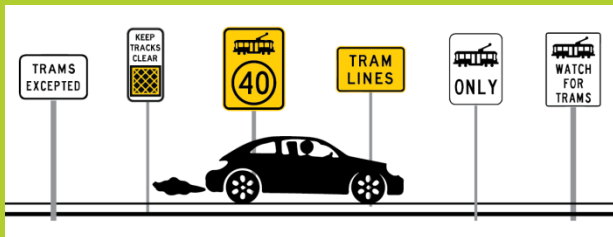

Overhead wires are live and trams are testing from the Gold Coast University Hospital Station at Parklands Drive to Broadbeach South Station.

### Works this weekend

The northbound lane of Scarborough Street will be closed from Sunday 13 April to 5:00am Monday 14 April for road profiling and final asphaltting between Nerang Street and Queen Street.

## Parklands

Kerb, footpath, drainage and landscaping works including night works continue.

Night works to install feature lighting on the Smith Street bridge will occur with lane closures occurring on the Smith Street Motorway. Detours via Olsen Avenue and Parklands Drive will be in place.

## Southport

### Queen Street

#### From Wardoo Street to Nerang Street

Finishing works continue including night works.

### Nerang Street

#### Between Queen and Davenport Street

Landscaping and finishing works including installation of electrical services in the footpath for feature lighting and construction of planter boxes and bike lockers continue. Night works and lane closures will occur.

#### Between Davenport Street and Scarborough Street

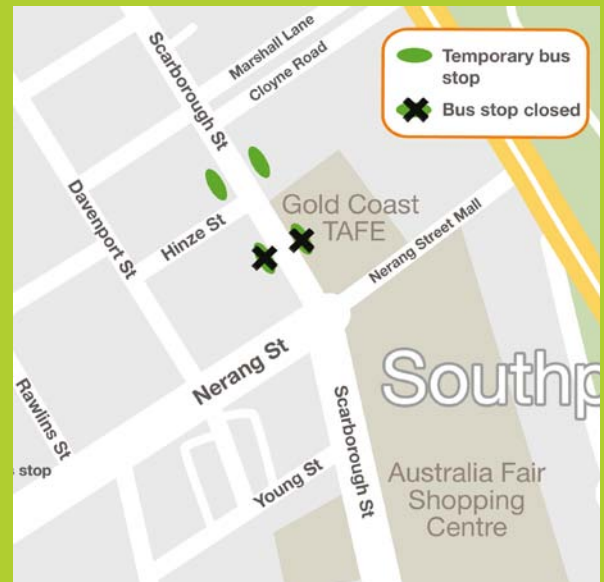
Landscaping, seat construction and station works continue including night works.

### Scarborough Street

## Scarborough Street bus stop relocation

The following temporary bus stop relocations are now in place.

- The southbound bus stop in front of the Gold Coast Institute of TAFE building is now located 100 metres north near Cloyne Road
- The northbound bus stop in front of Southport Police station is located 100 metres north between Hinze and Hicks Street.

## Scarborough Street closures

The northbound lane of Scarborough Street between White and Queen Street will reopen on Thursday 17 April.

Night closures of the southbound lane from Nerang Street to Queen Street will continue from 7:00pm to 5:00am, Monday to Friday.

Footpath and landscape works continue in Southport. The work involves jack-hammering and removing the current pavement, replacing and levelling underground service pit lids and laying a new concrete base and pavers. Day, night and weekend work will occur.

### Near Hinze Street

Day and night works will continue to complete underground service installation, new footpaths and bus stop construction.

Finishing works will continue including landscaping, concreting medians, underground services and footpath works.

### Between Nerang Street and Queen Street

Paving, concrete pours, demolition and retaining wall construction will continue from Lawson Street to Nerang Street on the eastern and western footpaths.

### Queen Street

#### From Scarborough Street to Barney Street

Night works will continue for landscaping and finishing works. Lane closures will occur.

## Nerang River

### Shared cycle and pedestrian bridge

Piling and girder installation is now complete. Some access changes may be required on the pedestrian boardwalk under the bridge and some night works will be required.

### Nerang River barge movements

The barge Leonora is on the northern side of the river to the east of the traffic bridge. Mariners are advised to use caution. Details are available on the [Maritime Safety Queensland website](#).

## Paradise Waters

### Gold Coast Highway

Intermittent night works along the Gold Coast Highway from the Sundale Bridge to Ferny Avenue intersection may occur. Single lane closures will be in place along the Gold Coast Highway.

Landscape works continue along Commodore Drive. Lane closures may occur. Finishing and station works continue.

## Surfers Paradise

### Overhead wires are live and trams are testing from Southport to Broadbeach

Overhead wires are live and trams are testing from the Gold Coast University Hospital Station at Parklands Drive to Broadbeach South Station.

Always cross at designated crossings and look both ways before crossing the road and light rail tracks.

### Asphalting night works on Surfers Paradise Boulevard

Night works to complete the final asphalting along Surfers Paradise Boulevard will continue from:

- View Avenue to Elkhorn Avenue Intersection

Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be closed to southbound traffic each night.

On Wednesday 16 April the intersection of Elkhorn Avenue intersection will be closed to traffic. Detours to Thomas Drive and Chevron Island will be signed.

### Ferny Avenue to View Avenue

Finishing works, including asphalting, kerbing, footpaths and landscaping continue. Night and weekend works will occur. Station works continue.

The southbound bus stop on the Gold Coast Highway at Ocean Avenue has been temporarily relocated 100 metres north, adjacent to Golden Gate. Services will not be affected.

## Surfers Paradise Boulevard closed from Ocean Avenue to Staghorn Avenue

Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be closed to traffic from 6:30pm to 6:30am, Sunday to Thursday, from Ocean Avenue to Staghorn Avenue to facilitate footpath construction.

## Surfers Paradise Boulevard closed from Main Beach Parade to Ocean Avenue

From Monday 14 April Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be closed to traffic from Main Beach Parade to Ocean Avenue from 6:30pm to 6:30am, Sunday to Thursday to facilitate footpath construction on the eastern side.

## Traffic Changes on the Gold Coast Highway and Ocean Avenue

The Gold Coast Highway will reopen to two lanes southbound from Thursday 17 April to Tuesday 22 April. Ocean Avenue and Gold Coast Highway intersection will remain closed during this time.

From Tuesday 22 April construction will continue to install a right turn lane from the Gold Coast Highway northbound into Ocean Avenue. The Gold Coast Highway will be reduced to one lane southbound from Ferny Avenue intersection to Pandanus Avenue. Ocean Avenue is reopened to two-way traffic but closed at the Gold Coast Highway intersection (see map).

Day, night and weekend work will occur. Traffic detours will be in place.

### View Avenue to Elkhorn Avenue

Night works continue to complete footpath subgrade installation along the western footpath.

Footpath removal and reinstatement works continue along:

- The eastern footpath from Elkhorn Avenue to Cavill Avenue

Paving works are underway along:

- The western footpath from Elkhorn Avenue to Cavill Avenue
- The western footpath from Cavill Avenue to Beach Road
- The eastern footpath from Cavill Avenue to Trickett Street

Station works continue.

## Trickett Street to Hamilton Avenue

### Surfers Paradise Boulevard closed from Laycock Street to Clifford Street

Surfers Paradise Boulevard is closed to traffic from Laycock Street to Clifford Street to facilitate footpath construction works. Night works will occur.

Footpath and landscaping works continue along Surfers Paradise Boulevard. The work involves jack-hammering and removing the current pavement and driveways, replacing and levelling underground service pit lids and laying a concrete base. Day, night and weekend work will occur.

Footpath removal, preparatory works, watermain investigation and reinstatement works continue along:

- The eastern footpath from Laycock Street to Clifford Street

## Clifford Street to Thornton Street

Works continue for underground services, traffic signal, footpaths, landscaping and station works. Night works will occur.

Footpath works continue on the eastern corners of Surfers Paradise Boulevard between Clifford Street and Hamilton Avenue. Day and night works will occur.

Night works will occur to install kerbing and drainage on the western side of Surfers Paradise Boulevard between Vista Street and Thornton Street.

## Broadbeach

### Overhead wires are live and trams are testing from Southport to Broadbeach

Overhead wires are live and trams are testing from the Gold Coast University Hospital Station at Parklands Drive to Broadbeach South Station.

Always cross at designated crossings and look both ways before crossing the road and light rail tracks.

## Gold Coast Highway Fern Street to Australia Avenue

Landscaping and station works continue. Lane closures will occur.

Night works continue between Fern Street and Australia Avenue for underground service works in the track slab. Lane closures will occur.

## Australia Avenue to Hooker Boulevard

Footpath, landscaping, line marking, traffic signal and station works continue. Lane closures will occur.

Night works continue between Australia Avenue and Pacific Fair Drive for underground service works in the track slab. Lane closures will occur.

On Tuesday 15 and Wednesday 16 April footpath works will occur at Casino Drive and Hooker Boulevard intersection. Access in and out of Casino Drive will be maintained.

On Monday 14 April night works will occur at the intersections of Hooker Boulevard, Gold Coast Highway and Casino Drive to facilitate traffic signal works. The intersections will be managed under traffic and police control.

Timing of these works is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.
