



Night works at Elkhorn Avenue intersection

Night works to finalise the construction of the eastern footpath along Surfers Paradise Boulevard from Elkhorn Avenue to Cavill Avenue continue. Works will take place for up to three weeks. Temporary footpath and lane closures will occur, traffic control will be on site to assist.

What to expect:

- Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be closed to southbound traffic between Elkhorn Avenue to Cavill Avenue each night from 6:30pm to 6:30am, Sunday to Friday.
- Temporary safety fencing and hoarding will be installed to contain the work area at night.
- Construction will involve the use of heavy machinery, including jack-hammers.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration will occur. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Pedestrian access and access to businesses will be maintained around the work site.
- Please drive to the conditions at all times as points of access will change.
- The majority of construction work will occur from Sunday to Friday, 6:30pm to 6:30am.
- Construction work will also be carried out between 6:30am and 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
