



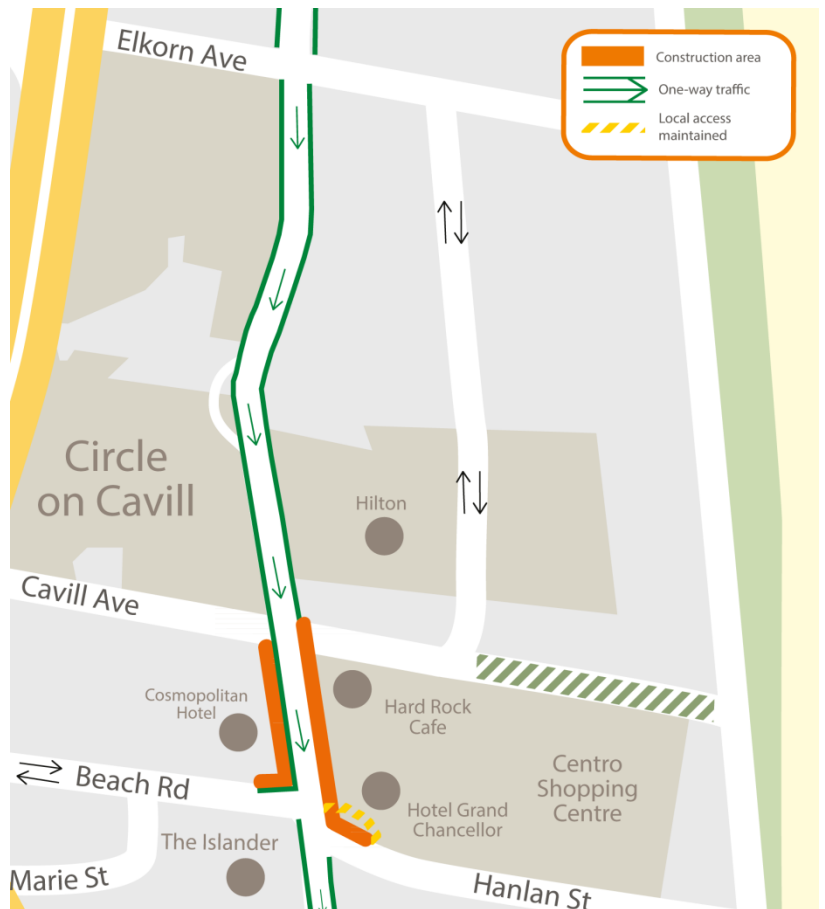
## Cavill Avenue Construction Works

Night works to replant palm trees will take place on Monday 19 May 2014 at the intersection of Cavill Avenue and Surfers Paradise Boulevard.

To facilitate revegetation, Cavill Avenue east will be temporarily closed from 8:00pm to 4:00am.

### Night works:

- Local access to Cavill Avenue and Orchid Avenue will be maintained via Elkhorn Avenue under traffic control for the duration of the closure.
- Orchid Avenue will become two-way during the temporary closure.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.



### What to expect:

- Installation of safety barriers and fencing to contain the construction area.
- Replanting of palm trees on the southern side of the intersection.
- Heavy machinery, excavation and crane movements to facilitate construction activities.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.
