



Night works at Surfers Paradise Boulevard

From Monday 19 May 2014, night works to finalise the installation of road marking and line marking Surfers Paradise Boulevard, from Elkhorn Avenue to Cavill Avenue, will take place for up to two weeks. Temporary footpath and lane closures will occur, traffic control will be on site to assist.

What to expect:

- Surfers Paradise Boulevard will be closed to southbound traffic from Elkhorn Avenue to Cavill Avenue each night to facilitate works.
- Installation of temporary safety fencing and hoarding to contain the work area at night.
- Construction will involve the use of heavy machinery, including compactors, to install road and line marking.
- Construction noise, dust and vibration will occur. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.
- Pedestrian access and access to businesses will be maintained around the work site at all times.
- Traffic management will be in place to assist motorists. Please drive to the conditions at all times as points of access will change.
- The majority of construction work will occur from Monday to Friday, 6:30pm to 6:30am.
- During night works vehicles will use “quacker” (quieter) style reversing alarms to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
