



Night works along Cavill Avenue on Wednesday 4 July

A short shift of night works will take place on the eastern-side of the intersection of Cavill Avenue and Surfers Paradise Boulevard between 12:00am (midnight) and 2:00am on Wednesday 4 July 2012. This closure will impact access to Cavill and Orchid Avenues.

Traffic impacts:

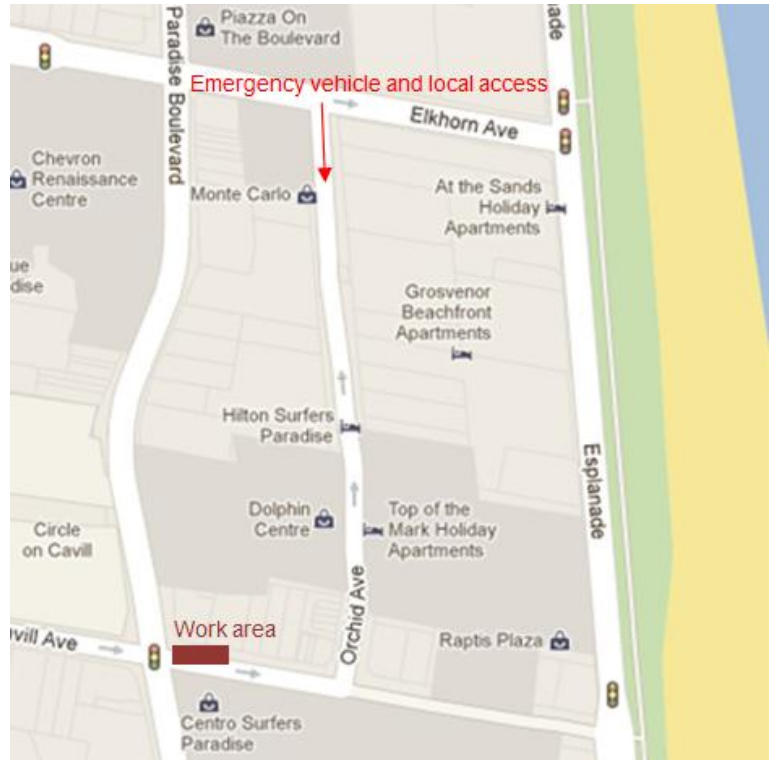
- **No traffic access to Orchid Avenue via Cavill Avenue.**
- Emergency vehicle and local access will be provided to Orchid Avenue from Elkhorn Avenue under Police and traffic control enabling southbound traffic movements.
- Alternative routes and redirections will be signed.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained during these works.

What to expect:

- Construction work will be carried out between 12:00am (midnight) and 2:00am.
- Temporary work areas contained by temporary safety fencing for underground public utilities (CCTV) investigations.
- Police and traffic control will be in place to assist motorists and pedestrians.
- Minor machinery noise. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.

Night works:

- This work will be undertaken at night to minimise traffic impact. Affected businesses and residents will be notified in advance of these works.
- During night works vehicles will use "quacker" style reversing alarms rather than beepers to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
