



Parking changes in Southport

As part of Queensland's first light rail construction, works will be undertaken in Nerang and Scarborough Streets in Southport. Construction will involve relocating underground services such as gas and water, upgrading storm water drainage, landscaping, track form works to lay the rail, five stations and landscaping.

On-street parking along sections of Nerang Street and Scarborough Street will be progressively and permanently removed.

Alternative parking opportunities are available to make it easy to access shops and businesses in Southport. Traffic and pedestrian movements will be maintained around work areas but the points of access may change. Please continue to support your local retailer during construction.

New parking

GoldLinQ will provide 60 new parking spaces in a laydown yard at the corner of Scarborough and Queen Streets. These spaces will be available for all day parking to free up parking close to the retail area of Southport. This will be managed by a commercial car parking company. GoldLinQ has also made 120 free centre-parking spaces available in Nerang Street until late 2012.

Parking zones

Gold Coast City Council has reallocated some parking in side streets to increase convenience for shoppers. There will be additional short term parking bays in Owens Lane, next to the Bendigo Bank, as well as in White and Young Streets.

Parking stations

There are several Gold Coast City Council operated parking stations a short walk from the Southport shopping precinct, at a rate of between \$1.00 and \$1.60 per hour. Gold Coast City Council car parks are located at:

- Lawson Street and Suter Street: Athol Paterson (next to the library car park) – holds 183 cars for a mix of three hour and all day parking.
- Hinze Street: Mal Bourke (near the Southport Courthouse) - holds 323 cars for short term or all day parking.
- Marine Parade: Carey Park - holds 360 cars for short term or all day parking.

Commercial car parks are also available at comparable rates at 25 Scarborough Street (the Little Theatre) and at 68 Nerang Street for up to 8 hours. There is also time limited parking available in Lawson Street under Southport Central.

Parking a little further away and walking could be good for your health and fitness. For the average person a 300 metre walk that takes a few minutes can burn up to 200 kilojoules!

Shopping centres

Parking at centres like the Australia Fair Shopping Centre are unchanged.

Motorcycle parking

Motorcycle parking in Scarborough Street has been relocated further north on Scarborough Street and in Young Street.

Loading bays and disabled parking

Disabled parking and loading bays will be maintained in the vicinity but will move in accordance with construction.
