Night works Gold Coast Highway and Monaco Street

Night works are required from Sunday 17 July 2011 for up to two weeks at the intersection of the Gold Coast Highway and Monaco Street, Surfers Paradise. All efforts will be made to keep disruption to a minimum during these works.

Works will involve:

- Sewer and Telstra relocation activities and road excavation works. This includes the use of trucks in the works zone and construction noise from the use of heavy machinery including excavators.

What to expect:

- From Sunday 17 July 2011 nightly between 7pm and 6am for up to one week the northbound turning slip lane from Monaco Street onto the Gold Coast Highway will be affected by these works. Traffic management will be in place to assist northbound motorists onto the Gold Coast Highway.
- From Sunday 24 July 2011 nightly between 7pm and 6am for up to one week, Telstra subcontractors will be required to dig trenches across Monaco Street to relocate communication cables.
- Speed limits will be reduced to 40km/hour in the project area during this time for the safety of motorists, pedestrians and construction workers.
- Localised noise from these works will occur, however every effort will be made to minimise impacts as much as possible. This includes planning the work so possible noisy works such as concrete cutting will be completed before 9pm.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather and construction conditions.
