Remembrance Drive, Surfers Paradise

Sunday 31 July – early August 2011

As a part of the road realignment to prepare for future works required at the intersection of Remembrance Drive and Surfers Paradise Boulevard, night works are required at Remembrance Drive, Surfers Paradise.

Works will involve:

- The progressive removal of the median in the centre of Remembrance Drive between Surfers Paradise Boulevard and Via Roma (Isle of Capri turn off).

What to expect:

- Remembrance Drive will be reduced to a single lane in each direction nightly between 7pm and 6am from Sunday 31 July until early August 2011.
- Some construction noise from the use of heavy machinery
- Truck movements in and around the work zone
- The use of temporary lighting
- Speed limits will be reduced to 40km/hour in the project area during this time for the safety of motorists, pedestrians and construction workers. Traffic management will be in place to direct motorists.

These works are being carried out at night to maintain two lanes of traffic during peak traffic flow times.

Timing of this work is subject to weather and construction conditions.

The Gold Coast Rapid Transit project is committed to minimising construction impacts on the community. During these night works, every effort will be made to keep noise to a minimum as much as possible. This includes planning of the work so very noisy works are completed prior to 9pm when ever possible. Temporary lighting will also be managed to ensure minimal impacts.
