

Gold Coast Rapid Transit

Fern Street temporary closure

Sunday 6 to Friday 18 November 2011

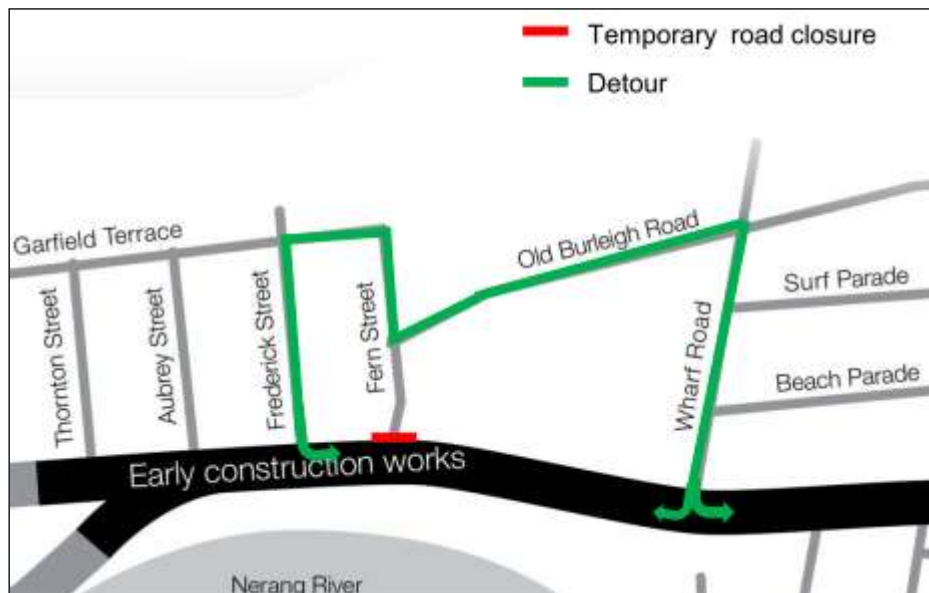
The intersection of Fern Street and the Gold Coast Highway will be closed from Sunday 6 to Friday 18 November 2011 to install essential services under the roadway.

Works will involve:

- The use of heavy machinery to excavate the road to install service conduits and pipes.

What to expect:

- The western end of Fern Street will be closed from Sunday 6 to Friday 18 November.
- Detour signs will be in place. Motorists will be directed north via Garfield Terrace and south via Wharf Road. See map below for detour routes.
- Some noise and other construction impacts may be experienced, however, every effort will be made to minimise disruption to the local community.
- Pedestrian access from the Gold Coast Highway into Fern Street will be maintained.
- Motorists and pedestrians are asked to drive/walk safely and observe the signage.
- Work hours will be 6.30am to 6.30pm Monday to Saturday, except for Sunday 6 November when traffic barriers will be put in place between 6.30pm and 10pm.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather and construction conditions.



These works are part of Stage One of the Gold Coast Rapid Transit project, which is delivering a world-class light rail system to the Gold Coast by 2014. Stage One will connect Griffith University with Broadbeach via Southport and Surfers Paradise.
