Safe Work Method Statements.

- Prestart inspections

Subcontractor Requirements

QUALITY

Own or Principal Contractor's QA system.

Department of Transport and Main Roads (DTMR) standards.

DTMR approved Contractors / Products for :

- Steel fabrication
- Precast
- Bearings and expansion joints
- Concrete

Inspection and documentation.

Subcontractor Requirements

Environmental

- Sediment and erosion control
- Dust
- Noise / vibration
- Cultural Heritage.

Community

- Respect
- Principal contractors community representative
- Minimise impacts.



Subcontractor Requirements

Leighton Contractors requires all sub-contractors to be code compliant.

National Code of Practice for the construction industry

Subcontractor Requirements

National Code of Practice (cont)

- Required for federally funded projects
- Subcontractor to comply including their subcontractors
- Required to:
 - Complete and sign the declaration of compliance
 - Advise us of the industrial instrument that would cover your employees for the on site activities, and
 - Provide us with evidence that the industrial instrument is compliant with the code and guidelines.
