Changes to traffic conditions on the Gold Coast Highway, Broadbeach

The Gold Coast Rapid Transit project is bringing a world class light rail system to the Gold Coast. To prepare the roadway for the future light rail alignment, roadworks are required on the eastern side of the Gold Coast Highway between Armrick Avenue and Australia Avenue, Broadbeach.

To prepare the roadway for the future light rail alignment, changes in traffic conditions on the Gold Coast Highway will be required.

From 28 March 2011, works include relocation of services, reconstruction of kerbs and footpaths and new road pavements. This work will be conducted in stages to minimise impacts to road users, pedestrians and residents.

These works will include:


- Temporary intersection closures of Britannia Avenue, Chelsea Avenue, Rosewood Avenue, and St Kilda Avenue.
- The bus stop currently located on the corner of Second Avenue and Gold Coast Highway will be moved further into Second Avenue to provide a safe entry and exit point for buses.
- The reopening of Armrick and Australia Avenues at the Gold Coast Highway intersection.
- The reopening of the northbound turning lane into Australia Avenue from the Gold Coast Highway.
- Access to Cascade Gardens will be modified. Entry and exit to the gardens will only be via the northbound lanes of the Gold Coast Highway. Motorists travelling southbound along the Gold Coast Highway are advised to proceed to T.E. Peters Drive and complete a U-turn movement.
