CHANGED TRAFFIC CONDITIONS THIS WEEK

Parklands Drive will be temporarily closed between Olsen Avenue and Alumni Place during night works
Nightly from Tuesday 15 to Sunday 20 March 2011
between 6.00pm and 5.00am

University Drive will be reduced to one lane
Wednesday 16 March 2011 between 5.00am and 6.00pm

What to expect:

- Construction activities on Parklands Drive and University Drive including:
 - Asphalt works
 - Barrier movement
 - Line marking.
- During the **night works**:
 - access into Griffith University will remain available via the Smith Street end of Parklands Drive into Engineering Drive and Alumni Place.
 - University drive will be intermittently closed however, every effort will be made to maintain access when possible.
- During the **daytime** lane closure on University Drive, traffic control will be in place to direct traffic one way at a time.
- Cyclists and pedestrians will still be able to access Griffith University and the Parklands Drive bus stop via the pedestrian detour along Parklands Drive and through Griffith University.
- Some noise from reversing beepers from machinery.
- Night works.

- After these works, traffic on Parklands Drive between Olsen Avenue and Alumni Place will be switched from the hospital side of Parklands Drive to the university side. Please take care when driving on Parklands Drive in these changed traffic conditions.

What we will do:

- Provide traffic control to assist motorists and pedestrians.
- Divert bus services around these works.
- Limit reversing movements where possible.
- Minimise noise where possible.
