TRAFFIC CHANGE Parklands Drive, Southport

From late July 2010

As part of the early works for the Gold Coast Rapid Transit project, Leighton Contractors has been appointed to construct the Gold Coast University Hospital Station shell. During July 2010, the project team will commence site establishment and preliminary works along Parklands Drive, between Olsen Avenue and Alumni Place.

Traffic on Parklands Drive between Olsen Avenue and Alumni Place will be reduced to one lane in each direction. This traffic arrangement is required for future precinct-wide development, and will be permanent between University Drive and Alumni Place.

The traffic changes along Parklands Drive will be applied as indicated in the map below. This change will include the introduction of a left in/left out configuration at the junction of University Drive and Parklands Drive. A speed limit of 40km/h will apply for the entire length of Parklands Drive during the construction period.

To ensure the safety of all road users and construction staff this traffic change will be carried out at night. Traffic controllers will be on site to assist with traffic management during the implementation of this change.
