

# Gold Coast Rapid Transit

## Southport roadworks

24 June 2011

The following construction works are expected in the Southport roadworks area in the coming fortnight (weather and construction conditions permitting).

### Zone 1: Queen Street

#### (Wardoo Street to Nerang Street)

- Works are continuing on the construction of new drainage culverts in Loders Creek, Fass Park and on the residential side of Queen Street (opposite Southport State School).
- In the northern sections of Mal Burke Street, Bambarra Street, Prince Street and Ward Street, works are continuing on the installation of new underground services. Access to these streets via Queen Street will be temporarily unavailable from time-to-time.
- During June 2011, Energex crews will be undertaking works along Queen Street and surrounding streets to install new overhead and underground power lines. Energex will contact individual property owners to arrange connections to the new power services.  
Frequent truck movements are expected along local streets during these works, and Energex trucks will be parked along the side of the road at times.
- On the residential side of the street, underground services relocations, drainage works, and works at individual properties are continuing.

### Zone 2a: Nerang Street

#### (Queen Street to High Street)

- Two-way traffic on Nerang Street has been moved to the northern (commercial) side of the road, to allow underground services relocations / installations to be carried out on the southern (Gold Coast Hospital) side of the road.  
As part of this traffic change, the southbound u-turn facility on High Street (at the Nerang Street / High Street intersection) has been permanently removed.
- The project team has temporarily reinstated some short-term free parking bays on the northern side of Nerang Street, west of Cougal Street and outside the Pacific Private Clinic building, to assist local businesses and medical centres.

These parking bays are subject to movement and may be temporarily removed with little / no notice from time-to-time while works are underway nearby.

- Works to install a new drainage pipeline in Nerang Street between Queen Street and Cougal Street are almost complete. This fortnight, a road crossing of the pipeline will be undertaken from Cougal Street to the opposite side of Nerang Street. One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction on Nerang Street during these works.
- Energex crews are continuing works near Gold Coast Hospital (on Queen Street and Nerang Street) to install new overhead and underground power lines. Energex will contact individual property owners to arrange connections to the new power services.  
Frequent truck movements are expected along Queen and Nerang Streets during these works, and Energex trucks will be parked along the side of the road at times.
- Access pits are currently being constructed at intervals along Nerang Street (on the Gold Coast Hospital side) to allow tunnel boring machines to be used for telecommunications services installation.

Current pedestrian movements may be affected. Changes will be signed, and traffic controllers will be in place to direct pedestrians around the works.

### Zone 2b: Nerang Street

#### (High Street to Davenport Street)

- Deep excavation works are continuing on the southern side of Nerang Street (between High Street and Garden Street) to allow a large diameter water pipeline to be installed. The new water pipeline will be installed using both open trench and tunnelling construction methods.
- Works to install a new drainage pipeline on the southern side of Nerang Street between Garden Street and Davenport Street have commenced.

# Southport roadworks

- During June 2011, Energex crews will be undertaking works along Nerang Street and surrounding streets to install new overhead and underground power lines. In the coming weeks, Energex will contact individual property owners to arrange connections to the new power services.

Frequent truck movements are expected along local streets during these works, and Energex trucks will be parked along the side of the road at times.

## Zone 3: Queen Street

(Lenneberg Street to Marine Parade via Ada Bell Way) and Scarborough Street (Queen Street to Park Lane)

- Demolition works on Queen Street and Swan Lane are scheduled to be completed in mid-2011.
- Works to relocate existing underground services in Matron and Sister Higman Park, Ada Bell Way and Queen Street are progressing well.

This fortnight, some road crossings will occur to install new electrical, telecommunications and drainage services across Ada Bell Way and Queen Street. These works will involve excavation and laying of pipes using open trench and tunnel boring construction methods. One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction during the works.

- From 29 June until mid July 2011, works will be undertaken to install new telecommunications services in Queen Street between Ada Bell Way and Como Crescent. These works will involve excavation and laying conduits using open trench construction methods. On-street parking on the southern side of Queen Street will be temporarily unavailable while these works are carried out.

All efforts will be made to keep disruption to a minimum. We thank you for your patience and cooperation.

## Southport roadworks

### Nerang Street (Queen Street to High Street) - current traffic and parking arrangements

Since late 2010, the project team has been undertaking major roadworks and underground services relocations / installations on the northern side of Nerang Street between Queen Street and High Street.

These works have progressed well and the project team is now preparing to undertake major roadworks and underground services relocations / installations on the southern side of Nerang Street, outside Gold Coast Hospital.

Two-way traffic on Nerang Street was moved to the northern side of the road earlier this week. As part of this traffic change, on-street parking on the southern side of Nerang Street was removed.

Since the traffic switch, the project team has reassessed parking arrangements along Nerang Street and been able to temporarily reinstate some short-term free parking bays on the northern side of the road. Parking bays have been temporarily reinstated west of Cougal Street and outside the Pacific Private Clinic building to assist local businesses and medical centres.

These parking bays are subject to movement and may be temporarily removed with little / no notice from time-to-time while works are underway nearby.
