

Gold Coast Rapid Transit

Road profiling, sealing and asphaltting works along Nerang Street (Queen Street to High Street)

Mid October - Mid November 2011

Roadworks to permanently improve the road surface along the southern (Gold Coast Hospital) side of Nerang Street between Queen Street and High Street will be undertaken from mid October 2011. These works will be carried out both during the day and at night.

Works will involve:

- Road profiling, sealing and asphaltting along the southern (Gold Coast Hospital) side of Nerang Street to permanently improve the road surface.

Works will begin near High Street and progress west towards Queen Street.

- Use / storage of heavy road construction equipment including a roller and profiler in the work zone.

What to expect:

- Works will be divided into two shifts each day, with road profiling and sealing generally carried out between 6.30am and 5.00pm. Asphaltting works will occur during the second shift, between 6.30pm and 5.00am.
- Emergency access to the Gold Coast Hospital will be maintained at all times during works.
- Access to driveways / businesses along the southern side of the road will be maintained wherever possible. At times, the road surface adjoining driveways may be a temporary loose gravel and motorists will be required to drive slowly / carefully.
- If short-term disruptions to driveways are required, a project team representative will provide advanced notification to affected businesses.
- Traffic controllers will be in place during the day to assist motorists entering and exiting driveways / businesses within the work zone.
- Two-way traffic will be maintained along the northern side of Nerang Street.

- Pedestrian / cyclist access along Nerang Street will be maintained on both the northern and southern sides of the road. The project team asks that pedestrians take the time to cross safely on Nerang Street, and use signalised crossings wherever possible.
- Localised noise, dust, odour and vibration can be expected during works. These impacts will be regularly monitored and reduced wherever possible.

All efforts will be made to keep disruption to a minimum. We thank you for your patience and cooperation.
