Nightworks to install and connect new wastewater and stormwater pipelines in Nerang Street, Southport

24 - 28 October 2011

One week of nightworks are required in Nerang Street during activities to connect a new wastewater pipeline to the existing network, and install and connect a new 50m section of stormwater pipeline along the northern side of Nerang Street.

Works will involve:

- On the night of Monday 24 October 2011, pipework connections between a newly installed wastewater pipeline and the existing network will be undertaken on the corner of Nerang Street and Cougal Street.
- During the nights of Tuesday 25 to Friday 28 October 2011, works will be undertaken to install and connect a 50m section of new stormwater pipeline along the northern side of Nerang Street, between Cougal Street and the Pacific Private Clinic.
- Should weather or construction conditions prevent these nightworks from occurring, works will be rescheduled for subsequent night(s).

What to expect:

- Nightworks will be undertaken from 6.30pm each night and be completed by 5.00am the following morning.
- Traffic on Nerang Street between Cougal Street and the Pacific Private Clinic will be reduced to one lane. Traffic will operate under a stop-and-go arrangement with traffic controllers in place to direct motorists.
Under this traffic arrangement, priority will be given to emergency vehicles travelling to / from Gold Coast Hospital and other medical centres in Nerang Street.
- Access to / from Cougal Street will be maintained at all times.
- Works are not expected to affect usual wastewater services for nearby commercial and residential properties.

- Increased truck and machinery movements along Nerang Street, Cougal Street and surrounding streets.
- Pedestrian access on Nerang Street will be maintained at all times.
- Nearby residents and business occupants can expect some noise, dust, vibration and odour during works. These impacts will be regularly monitored and reduced wherever possible.
- The speed limit in the works zone will be reduced to 40km/h for the safety of roadworkers and motorists.

All efforts will be made to keep disruption to a minimum. We thank you for your patience and cooperation.
