Traffic changes and temporary parking removal in Queen Street, Southport

Wednesday 29 June - mid July 2011

Works to install new underground telecommunication services in Queen Street at Southport will begin in late June 2011 and take approximately three weeks to complete, weather permitting. These works will involve some traffic changes and temporary parking removal between Ada Bell Way and Como Crescent.


Works will involve:

- Installation of new underground telecommunications services in Queen Street between Ada Bell Way and Como Crescent (refer to map).
- Excavation and laying of telecommunications services using open trench construction methods.

What to expect:

- On-street parking on the southern side of Queen Street between Ada Bell Way and Como Crescent will be temporarily unavailable while these works are carried out.
- One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction on Queen Street and traffic controllers will be in place to direct motorists during works.
- Pedestrian and driveway access to businesses along this section of Queen Street will be maintained.
- The speed limit in the works zone will be reduced to 40km/h for the safety of roadworkers and motorists.
- Construction work will generally be carried out from 6.30am to 6.30pm Monday to Saturday, weather permitting.
- There may be some localised noise, dust and vibration during works. These impacts will be regularly monitored and reduced wherever possible.

All efforts will be made to keep disruption to a minimum. We thank you for your patience and cooperation.
