

IMPORTANT ROAD CLOSURE INFORMATION - SUNDAY 1 JULY

Monday 25 June 2012

Dear Resident or Property Manager,

We wish to advise you of important road closure information affecting Frederick Street and Aubrey Street in Surfers Paradise on Sunday 1 July 2012 for the annual Gold Coast Airport Marathon.

Vehicles will not be able to enter or exit Frederick Street and Aubrey Street between 7:15am and 11:30am on Sunday 1 July.

More than 5,000 people taking part in the Gold Coast Airport Marathon will be running along Garfield Terrace at the eastern end of both Frederick Street and Aubrey Street at this time with road closures in place at those intersections for public safety. Road closures at the western end of Frederick Street and Aubrey Street at Surfers Paradise Boulevard due to Gold Coast Rapid Transit works means there are no entry or exit points to Frederick Street and Aubrey Street from 7:15am to 11:30am.

These road closures are due to an extraordinary and unavoidable situation for this year only, involving two key community projects. The closures have been planned in consultation with Gold Coast City Council, Queensland Police and Gold Coast Rapid Transit, and are in place to ensure the safety of participants, volunteers, spectators and residents.

It is advised that any necessary vehicle entry or exit to these streets is undertaken after 12:00pm on Sunday 1 July once Garfield Terrace is completely opened for the public. Entry will be permitted to these streets from Garfield Terrace before 7:15am under direction of police and road marshals positioned at each intersection. Exit will also be permitted before 7:15am from these streets into Garfield Terrace with vehicles to be directed north by police and road marshals to Thornton Street and onto Surfers Paradise Boulevard.

Between 7:15am and 11:30am vehicles will only be able to exit Frederick Street and Aubrey Street in the case of emergency. Queensland Police will be positioned at the intersection of Aubrey Street and Garfield Terrace and will manage emergency situations.

A map highlighting these road closures is on the reverse of this letter for your information.




Fig. 1: Map showing the road closures affecting Aubrey St and Frederick St on Sunday 1 July.
